

Statement of Faith

SALVATION

We are saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ: His death, burial, and resurrection. Salvation is a gift from God, not a result of our good works or of any human efforts.

REPENTANCE

Repentance is the commitment to turn away from sin in every area of our lives and to follow Christ, which allows us to receive His redemption and to be regenerated by the Holy Spirit. Thus, through repentance we receive forgiveness of sins and appropriate salvation.

SANCTIFICATION

Sanctification is the ongoing process of yielding to God's Word and His Spirit in order to complete the development of Christ's character in us. It is through the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God that the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life.

JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ is God the Son, the second person of the Trinity. On earth, Jesus was 100% God and 100% man. He is the only man ever to have lived a sinless life. He was born of a virgin, performed miracles, died on the cross for mankind and thus, atoned for our sins through the shedding of His blood. He rose from the dead on the third day according to the Scriptures, ascended to the right hand of the Father, and will return again in power and glory.

VIRGIN BIRTH

Jesus Christ was conceived by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit (the third person of the Trinity) in the virgin Mary's womb; therefore, He is the Son of God.

REDEMPTION

Man was created good and upright, but by voluntary transgression he fell; his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

REGENERATION

For anyone to know God, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential.

JESUS' BLOOD

The Blood that Jesus Christ shed on the Cross of Calvary was sinless and is 100% sufficient to cleanse mankind of all sin. Jesus allowed Himself to be punished for both our sinfulness and our sins, enabling all those who believe to be free from the penalty of sin, which is death.

JESUS CHRIST INDWELLS ALL BELIEVERS



ACCOUNTABILITY FOR OUR CHURCH

The Role of the Executive Board

The Executive Board provides protective covering and guidance for the church relating to bylaws and business, as well as advice and support to the Senior Pastor. Executive Board members are nominated by the Senior Pastor and ratified by the Board of Deacons.

The Role of the Pastoral Team and Ministry Leads

The Pastoral Team and ministry leads, directed by the Senior Pastor, oversee the day-to-day ministry and operations of the Church.

The Role of the Board of Deacons

The Board of Deacons is a committed group of leaders already serving long-term in other areas of ministry. They are invited by the senior Pastor to ratify Executive Board members and their own leadership.

The Role of the Association of Related Churches (ARC)

ARC is an association of like-minded Churches numbering over 500 and growing. The purpose of ARC is to provide support, guidance and resources to launch and grow life-giving churches. It is not a denomination, but rather an association of churches linking arms for a common goal to spread the gospel. Countryside is honored to be an ARC Church to help start and grow new churches all over the world.
